

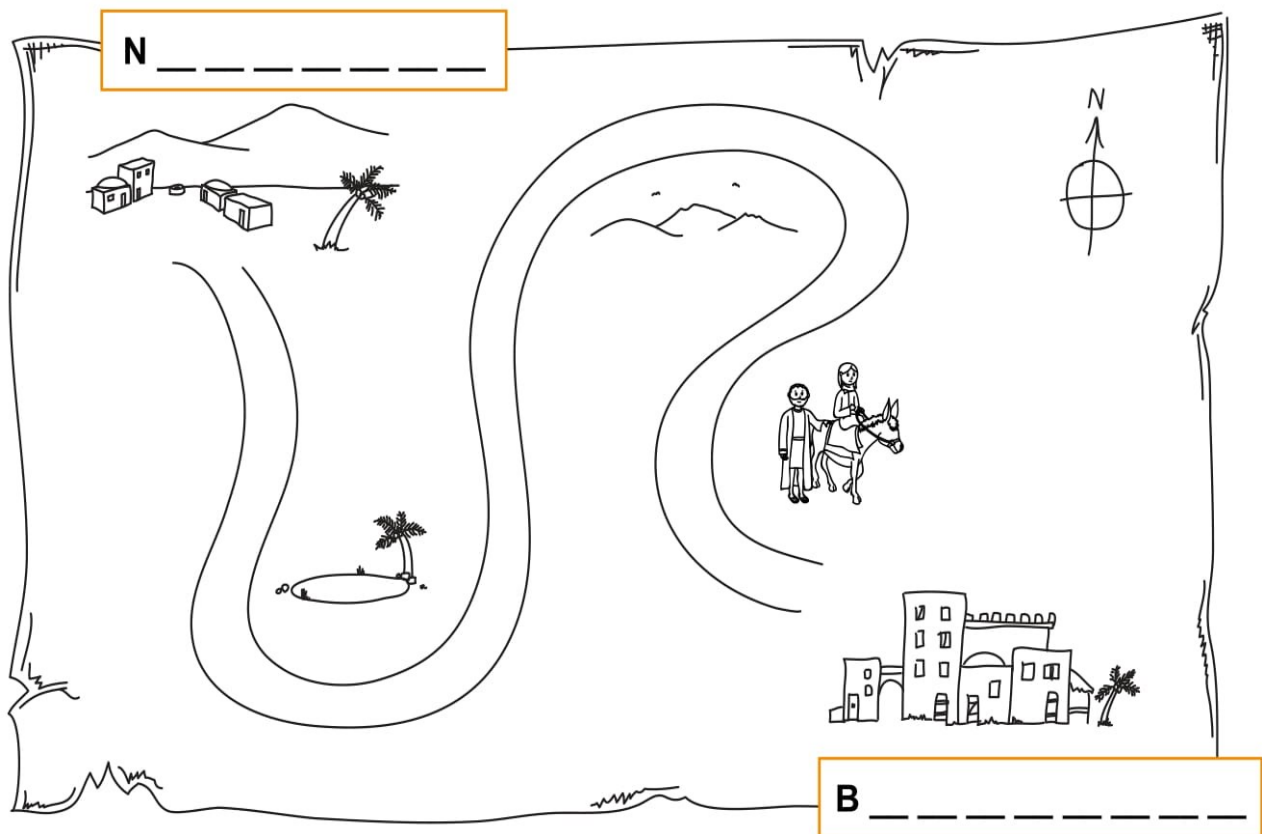

The Birth of Jesus

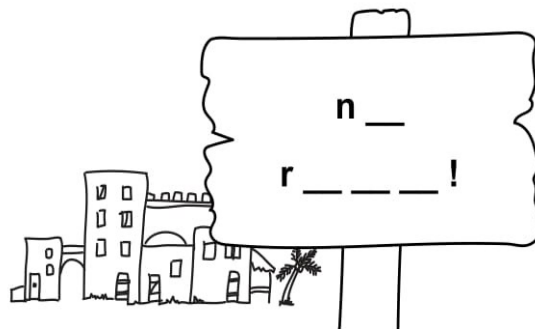

Label Nazareth and Bethlehem and add more people on the journey.



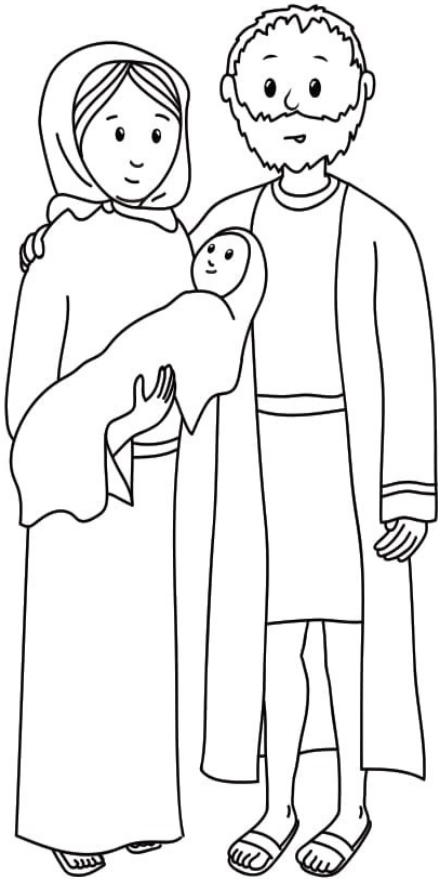
When they arrived, they could not find anywhere to stay. The inns were full. There was no room.
